RULES AND REGULATIONS

ADMISSION AND DEPARTURE OF HORSES

Admission: Horses will be admitted to the grounds at 12:01 am, Tuesday, April 22, 2025. If you need to arrive prior to that date, please contact the Stabling Manager.

No one will be admitted for stall decorating, bedding, etc. before Tuesday at 12:01 a.m. without prior notification to the Stabling Manager

Departure: <u>All horses must be outside the barn by 12:00 noon on Sunday, April 27, 2025.</u> An <u>additional fee of \$50</u> will be assessed for each horse occupying a stall, at noon Sunday, April 28, 2023.

ARRIVALS PRIOR TO TUESDAY AT 12:01 AM REQUIRE NOTIFICATION TO THE STABLING MANAGER. NO EXCEPTIONS. THE OHIO EXPO CENTER HORSE BARN IS LOCKED AND CANNOT BE ACCESSED WITHOUT A KEY/ APPROVAL FROM THE OHIO EXPO CENTER.

GROUNDS AND FACILITY INFORMATION

DAMAGE: The OEC holds individuals, owners and exhibitors responsible for damages and/or theft incurred by them, or their agents, to barns or other properties on the show grounds and may bill them accordingly. The River Ridge Charity Horse Show will in no way be responsible for any loss/damage that may occur. The show management will not be responsible for or liable for injuries, theft and/or damages sustained in any way to exhibitors, spectators, employees or other interested parties.

PARKING: There will be a charge on every vehicle entering the fairgrounds. A permit sticker for four days, five days or longer may be purchased at the gate. TRAILERS OR VEHICLES may be parked on the West Side of the Stalling Area (west of the complex) and BEHIND THE FACILITY – The lined parking spaces (LOADING ZONES) are to be used for loading and unloading, they are not for general parking. Trailers are not to be parked south of the Coliseum. (Giant Slide Area) As soon as possible after unloading, you must remove your vehicles from the loading zones. Overnight parking is **not** permitted in the stabling area for transport vehicles.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Stable dogs must be confined to tack rooms or crated. Dog owners, failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty. Dogs are not permitted in the Coliseum, unless designated as a service dog.

DELIVERIES: Please watch show website for deliveries to your stable at the show or check with the show office. River Ridge will not responsible for items delivered to the fairgrounds/Ohio Expositions Center.

CAMPING: Camping spaces are available at a charge determined by the Ohio Expo Center. Some spaces are full hookup. Fees will be collected by SP+ or the parking attendants. Tow vehicles used to enter and leave the Expositions grounds are required to purchase a parking permit in addition to paying camping fees. Any horse trailer, utility trailer or vehicle utilizing water, electric and/or being used for camping purposes will be assessed a daily camping fee. USEF Motorized Vehicle Statement: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating and individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties.

Hover boards, skateboards and bicycles are not to be ridden in the horse stabling area by juveniles.

SHARPS: Sharp containers are provided in convenient locations throughout the barn for the disposal of needles and other disposable sharp instruments. Show management may fine any individuals, including trainers, owners, exhibitors or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles and other sharp disposable instruments.

SHOW RING – FOOTING - Footing is comprised of sand, loam and wood shavings with a dirt base. Schooling before the show Tuesday from 7 am to 6 pm and then under the lights from 7 pm to 10 pm. During the show, ring will be open between sessions **until 1 hour prior to each session**.

SHOW RING SIZE: 112' x 225' Covered warm up ring 100' x 200'.

TRAINING AIDS: Attention getting devices and/or other noisemakers (including but not limited to tape measures, blow horns, bamboo poles, explosives, fire extinguishers, baby powder, and whips longer than 6 ft.; etc.) are not permitted in and around the makeup and competition rings, during scheduled sessions. All such items may be confiscated.

STALLS AND STABLING

Each horse stall / tack stall is \$145.

- **ONLY WHOLE STALLS** may be ordered and paid for on the entry form. We will **NOT DIVIDE STALL FEES** among your clients.
- Stalls may not be sold or given away; any stall transactions must go through the Horse Show Office.
- Damage to stalls is at the owner's expense. Please do not use nails, screws, staples or tape. Drilling is prohibited.
- All stall decorations must be removed prior to departure from the grounds.

Assignment of stalls is the sole discretion of Show Management. Considerations may include, but are not limited to the following, nor are they necessarily in the following order: number of total stalls requested and paid for, history of attendance, history at a particular location, support of the show (which includes personal time, attendance/exhibition of horses and financial contribution).

STALLS are permanent (vinyl & steel) 10 x 10 with doors. Stalls and aisleways must be kept clean and maintained throughout the show.

PRE-BEDDING of stalls and stall mats are available exclusively by Kuhlwein Feed & Bedding. Contact Chad Kuhlwein at (614) 989-2142

The Ohio Expo Commission reserves the right to take stall counts. Count may be taken any time during the show.

SPONSORSHIPS & BOX SEATING INFORMATION

SPONSORSHIPS: Please see the website for sponsorship opportunities. All sponsorships are welcome.

BOX SEATS: Boxed seating WILL be reserved on a first come, first serve basis after the Gold and Silver boxes have been assigned. Boxed seating is available in the following sizes: 6 seats for \$175.00; 8 seats for \$225.00; or 10 seats for \$300.00. Reservations must be made on the entry blank and submitted by the entry deadline. Box seats requested upon arrival at the show may not be available and we will be unable to accommodate your request. If Show Management can accommodate requests for box seating upon arrival at the show, your stable name may not be displayed at the box.

ENTRY AND CLASS INFORMATION

ENTRIES: Pre-entries close April 7, 2025. Entries postmarked after the closing date and may be considered late entries and will be assessed at \$25 per horse late fee. Entries must be on a River Ridge Horse Show Entry form signed by the exhibitor, rider, driver, handler, and trainer. In the case the exhibitor, rider, driver or handler is under the age of 18, his/her parent or guardian, must sign an entry blank on the minor's behalf.

Entries may also be made online via www.horseshowsonline.com.

ONLINE ENTRY PROCEDURES:

If you choose to enter through HorseShowsOnline.com, you must follow this procedure. Credit cards are required for the online entry procedure.

REMEMBER, even if you are entering online, stalls will not be assigned until payment for them has been received.

- 1. Make your entry online.
- 2. Do not attempt to correct your entry online once it has been submitted. Corrections have to done through the mail or at the horse show.
- 3. Even though you have made your entries online, you are still required to follow normal entry rules, i.e. copies of registration papers, Coggins, membership copies, measurement card copies, etc. and payment should be mailed by entry closing date.
- 4. Post entry fees will apply if payment is not post marked by closing date.
- 5. Credit cards will be accepted. Credit cards may be used for payment of all fees. A 4% convenience fee will be applied to all credit card accounts.

USEF FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT:

FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT USEF LITE COMPETITION By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of _River Ridge Horse Show (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos,

audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR908.4. If not currently a USEF Active Competing member or Subscriber, I acknowledge and agree that I will be enrolled at no cost as a USEF Fan and my USEF Fan Account will continue to annually automatically renew unless USEF determines in its sole discretion to terminate my status as a Fan. Additionally, I acknowledge that the benefits of a USEF Fan are subject to change without notice. USEF may in its sole discretion, at any time, terminate my USEF Fan status. BY SIGNING BELOW, I AGREE that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time, as well as all terms and provisions of this Prize List. If I am signing and submitting this Agreement electronically, I acknowledge that my electronic signature shall have the same validity, force and effect as if I affixed my signature by my own hand

CONDUCT:

It is the tradition of the competition ring that riders and drivers be correctly attired for the class in question, that attendants be neatly dressed, and horses be properly presented.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: **Coggins:** ALL horses (including Ohio horses) must be accompanied by a record of a negative official test for Equine Infectious Anemia conducted within the previous 12 months (negative IA, test date, lab and accession number). **Health Certificates:** All horses, including horses in Ohio, must be accompanied by an official, current (30 days) interstate health certificate. THE ORIGINAL OR PHOTCOPY OF THE ABOVE ITEMS MUST BE CARRIED WITH YOU. DO NOT FORWARD WITH YOUR ENTRY. **Vaccinations:** Horses more than seven months of age entering the grounds must be accompanied by documents of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinophneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables.

NON-SHOWING HORSES: All health requirements apply to these horses and horse are required to have a stall.

FEES, PAYMENTS, & CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

CHECK-IN/CHECK-OUT: No check-outs will be done on <u>Saturday, between 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.</u> Management respectfully requests you allow us to prepare for the show during this time.

CURRENCY: **All fees are stated in US currency**. MasterCard, Visa or American Express may be used for payment of fees. A 4% convenience fee will be applied to all credit card accounts. All accounts must have a signed open check or credit card on file before entry numbers will be handed out. *REMINDER*: Stalls will not be reserved unless paid in full. A SIGNED OPEN CHECK OR CREDIT CARD must be left in the office for payment of your account. **The horse show office will not be open to close your accounts on Sunday morning following the show.**

There will be no adjustments to accounts after Saturday, April 27, 2025.

CREDIT CARDS: MasterCard, Visa or American Express may be used for payment of fees. All credit card accounts will be charged a 4% convenience fee. Failure to supply a valid credit card may result in an additional fee of \$200 for a declined card.

RETURNED CHECK/INVALID CREDIT CARD: A penalty of \$200 will be charged for all returned checks OR invalid credit cards. Cash or certified funds must replace returned checks and/or credit card.

ENTRY FEES: Entry fees are dependent upon the class entered. Please refer to the Class Division & Fees Section.

OFFICE FEES: \$30 per horse

THE SUNRISE JUNIOR HUNTER CHALLENGE:

Prize money will be awarded according to the specifications listed elsewhere in the prize list concerning the Challenge.

PREMIUM SCHEDULE: Prize Money and 6 Ribbons in all classes unless otherwise specified. Equitation classes have 8 ribbons.

PRIZE MONEY: Prize money will be paid by check and will be mailed within 30 days of the closing of the show. Checks for prize money become non-negotiable after 60 days and are considered a contribution to the show. Show management will NOT attempt to obtain addresses that are not complete, illegible or incorrect on entry blanks.

UPHA CLASSES

UPHA \$250 ADDED CLASSICS. Open to mares, geldings and stallions age three (3) years and under for the American Saddlebred; age FOUR (4) years only for the Morgan; and, four (4) years of age and under for the Hackney. Horses/ponies must recorded with the UPHA. <u>The owner, trainer AND RIDER/DRIVER must be a UPHA member</u>. Nominating fees must be paid to UPHA by April 1, 2025. A declaration fee of \$50 is due by the closing date of April 1, 2025 with your entries. A showing fee is payable twenty-four (24) hours prior to the scheduled Classic. Classic fees are non-refundable in all situations. If April Nomination Fee has not been paid, a \$150 Nomination Fee must be paid to UPHA in addition to the entry fee along with any UPHA membership fees. Prize money is divided according to the rules set by the UPHA.

The ASB 5 Gaited, ASB 3 Gaited, Hackney Roadster Pony and Morgan Pleasure Driving UPHA Classic classes are sponsored by UPHA Chapter 13.

UPHA Equitation riders must be UPHA members. This includes 10 and under equitation riders.

CLASS CHANGES AND ACCOMODATIONS

ADDITIONAL CLASSES: Management reserves the right to add additional classes to the show schedule and will make every effort to inform exhibitors of the class(es). Classes will only be added **IF** there is a minimum of 3 horses for the class and a sponsorship of \$250 has been paid to the show.

CHANGES/CANCELLATIONS Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any class having less than (3) entries. Management reserves the right to change or alter the officials listed without prior notice to or during the show.

CHANGES/SCRATCHES: All changes & scratches must be completed <u>ONE HOUR</u> before the start of each session. Failure to scratch at least one (1) hour prior to the start of the performance which the horse is entered may subject exhibitor to a penalty of \$50. Emergency scratches will be handled by Paddock Master and Show Office on a per horse basis. The add/scratch feature through Horseshowsonline.com will be open for your use until one (1) hour prior to each session.

Entries, entry changes, adds/scratches sent via Facebook or Messenger will be ignored. We are unable to monitor these areas during the show. You may text changes to 740-464-5053 or email to plpony425@hotmail.com.

CLASS CALLS: Every effort will be made to maintain a working PA system. However, due to unforeseen problems, with any mechanical device, the PA system and paddock calls must be considered a courtesy. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be sure that his/her horse is at the gate at the prescribed time. A two (2) minute gate rule will be strictly enforced. The ingate will be closed two (2) minutes after the first horse enters the ring.

GATE HOLDS: There will be no holds. There will be no delay between classes. Exhibitors are warned about entering classes which may run back to back. Scheduling conflicts are the responsibility of the exhibitor. A backup rider/driver/handler is recommended if you have entries in more than one session.

SPLITTING OF CLASSES: Should the number of entries warrant, the Show Management reserves the right to split any class. The final number of entries in a class will be determined one hour prior to the session in which the class in question is to be held. Each split will receive duplicate awards in the preliminary classes.

CLASS ELIGIBILITY

CHAMPIONSHIPS: To be eligible for CHAMPIONSHIP classes, entries must have been entered, shown and judged in one of the like classes in that section. Championship classes will not be stripped.

STAKES. Exhibitors/horses do not need to qualify for classes designated as Stakes.

RIDER'S AGE: For Horse Show Office purposes, please be sure to show age of rider, as of 12/01/2024 on entry form.

AMATEURS / ADULTS: Amateur and adult classes are limited to competitors 18 years of age or older as of December 1, 2024. Exception: Participants in the Morgan Junior Exhibitor Park Saddle and Morgan Junior Exhibitor Park Harness are permitted to enter the Morgan Amateur Championship, if there are no junior exhibitor championships offered in these divisions. Any horse shown by an amateur in a ladies or youth class, qualifies for an amateur championship if no ladies or youth class, qualifies for an amateur championship if no ladies or youth class.

MASTER CLASSES: Class are open to amateurs who are age 50 and older.

MORGAN HORSES: May cross enter provided they meet all criteria of the division.

MAIDEN/NOVICE/LIMIT RIDER/HORSE CLASSES: Maiden/Novice/Limit classes are open to horses/riders/drivers who have not won one/three/six first place ribbons respectively, at any Federation Licensed Competitions or at any non-USEF but ASHA recorded competitions in any under saddle/driving class of any Breed and/or Discipline. Beginning April 1, 2019 first place ribbons in any under saddle class count towards Maiden/Novice/Limit status of a horse/rider in any under saddle class but do not affect the status of a horse/driver in any driving class. Conversely, status for Maiden/Novice/Limit for Driving classes does not affect the status for Maiden/Novice/Limit in any under saddle classes. Winning classes in Equitation, Academy, Lead Line, and/or non-cantering classes will not affect the Maiden/Novice/Limit status of a horse or rider. Ribbons won in leadline classes and in classes where entries are not required to canter will not affect Maiden, Novice and Limit Status. See exceptions for Hackney Ponies. Please be aware that entries in these classes are subject to verification of status.

OHIO OWNED CLASSES: Horses must be owned by an Ohio resident 90 days prior to the River Ridge Horse Show commencement. Horses may be stabled out of state. Horses shown in Ohio Owned Stakes will qualify for the championships offered in that division, i.e. a horse shown by a junior exhibitor would qualify for the junior exhibitor championship or if the horse is shown by an adult amateur it would qualify for the amateur championship.

SELECT SERIES: Horses shown in the Select Series class(s) will qualify for the championship(s) offered in the like division. A horse shown in the Select Series by a junior exhibitor will qualify for the junior exhibitor championship and a horse shown by an Adult Amateur will qualify for the adult amateur championship in that division.

MEMBERSHIPS

ASSOCIATION FEES: Money for any/all association membership fees (i.e. ASHA. AHHS, UPHA) must be payable to the association by using a separate check for each association.

AMERICAN SADDLEBRED MEMBERSHIP: Please include your membership numbers on the entry blank and enclose a copy of your membership card with your entries. Show results will be forwarded to ASHA within 10 days of the show.

AMERICAN HACKNEY HORSE SOCIETY: Please include your membership number on the entry blank and enclose a copy of your membership card.

UPHA MEMBERSHIPS: COPIES OF UPHA MEMBERSHIP CARDS MUST BE INCLUDED WITH ENTRIES. All participants (rider, driver, handler, owner, trainer) must present to the show secretary a current UPHA membership card or copy or join at the show.

USEF Membership Statement: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above, Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage Competitions, Endurance Rides and Vaulting Competitions: (See GR828.4 of the Federation rules). Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR231) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.

PHOTOGRAPHY

PHOTOGRAPHY: Howard Schatzberg Photography is the exclusive photographer for the River Ridge Horse Show. Any other photography taken, for commercial or advertising purposes, of subjects within the show ring, without prior written consent of Show Management is expressly forbidden. Violation of this rule will be grounds for removal from the show grounds. Individuals are permitted to take photographs for personal use and/or editorial use: however, the sale of said photographs is prohibited. Personal photographs may not be taken from ringside or the seating areas.

The Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge Class No. 114

Classes will be held at shows throughout the calendar year. The class will be called The Sunrise Junior Horse Hunter Challenge open to horse 4 and under and shown by an Amateur or professional. Each class throughout the year will be a \$350 class with the entry fee for each class being \$50 which will be added back in to the class payout. Sunrise Stables will provide the class sponsorship, ribbons and trophies for each class (if outside sponsorship can be obtained for these classes it is encouraged). Each show will be responsible for paying out the prize money. Payouts will be 40%,20%,15%, 10%, 10%, 5% for each class. If less than 6 horses are in the class money not paid out will be divided evenly amongst ribbon winners.

Class points will be tabulated throughout the year using the Saddle Horse Report Point System. The final show of the year will be the Ocala International Horse Show. The high point winners will be announced after the class is completed. If the winners are in attendance they will be recognized. The payouts and awards will be sent to all those not in attendance. Sunrise Stables will provide the sponsorship of \$5000 with additional prize money being added from sponsors and additional prizes. **Freedman Harness** will award the high point winner a Freedman Hunt Bridle and **Saddle Horse Report** will award the 1st and 2nd place high point winner a full page ad. 
Teams will be judged using the MOS 3 Judge System and judges will be announced prior to the class.

For and in consideration of United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. dba US Equestrian ("USEF") allowing me, the undersigned, to participate in any capacity (including as a rider, driver, handler, vaulter, longeur, lessee, owner, agent, coach, official, trainer or volunteer) in a USEF sanctioned, licensed or approved event or activity, including but not limited to equestrian clinics, practices, shows, competitions and related or incidental activities and

("USEF Event" or "USEF Events"); I, for myself, and on behalf of my spouse, children, heirs and next of kin, and any legal and personal representatives, executors, administrators, successors, and assigns, hereby agree to and make the following contractual representations pursuant to this Agreement (the "Agreement"):

A. RULES AND REGULATIONS: I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

B. ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISK: I knowingly, willingly, and voluntarily acknowledge the inherent risks associated with the sport of equestrian and know that horseback riding and related equestrian activities are inherently dangerous, and that participation in any USEF Event involves inherent risks and dangers. "Inherent risk of an equine activity" means a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following: (a) The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine; (b) The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (c) Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions; (d) A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object; (e) The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant; (f) the potential for serious bodily injury (including broken bones, head or neck injuries), sickness and disease (including communicable diseases), trauma, pain & suffering, permanent disability, paralysis and death; (g) loss of or damage to personal property (including my mount & equipment) arising out of the unpredictable behavior of horses; (h) exposure to extreme conditions and circumstances; accidents involv-ing other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; (i) contact or collision with other participants, event staff, volunteers or spectators; (l) catact or collision with other participants and horses, natural or manmade objects; (p) adverse weather conditions; (k) facilities issues and premises conditions; (l) failure of protective equipment (including helmets); (m) inadequate safety measures; (n) participants of varying
